


St. Francis of Asisi **Patron Saint of Ecology** 4th October

### Ecological Parish Protocol E:18

[Ecological Accountability #18: Grow local trees and other local plants in the church compound. Church grounds should be as green and biodiverse as possible with no or minimal exposure bare soil or tarred or cemented surfaces]



- 1. A garden parish surrounded by greenery.
- 2. Improvement to existing parish plant nursery



# Ecological Parish Protocol E:10/E:11/E:12

Ecological Accountability #10: Serve plant based food, predominantly or wholly, at parish events. Avoid meat, seafood and dairy as far as possible. Ecological Accountability #11: Institute Food catering rules for all parish activities where food is served.

Ecological Accountability #12: Work towards zero waste of food and other products on church premises. Compost food and other organic waste. Reduce, reuse, repurpose and recycle as much as possible. Any disposal of e-waste must be properly done, especially of old refrigerators and air-conditioners which can leak out toxic greenhouse gases.



Eco Policy Extension to External Suppliers

[Caterers & Contractors]

Caterers – Institute Food catering rules for all parish activities where food is served.

Contractors – Any disposal of demolition waste such as concrete, bricks, tiles, ceramics to be handled by themselves.







## Ecological Parish Protocol E:13

Ecological Accountability # 13 Set up recycling/repurposing/exchange centre or ecological store. Establish "Reuse Days' where people bring their used items still in good condition and offer them to others.

- Set up recycling/repurposing/exchange centre or ecological corner.
- Accept used items such as books, clothing & appliances
- Sunday Pre-loved/Bundle sales monthly from September 2024.

## [Cut down meat, dairy and food waste] Ecological Parish Protocol E:10

[Ecological Accountability # 10 – Serve plant-based food, predominantly or wholly, at parish events. Avoid meat, seafood and dairy as far as possible]

Cut down on meat, seafood and dairy consumption – Every Wednesday and Friday.

[Ecological Spirituality, Ecological Education & Integration # 2 : Inspire love and care for creation among the faithful through prayer, liturgies, Masses, cell group/BEC reflections, communications, campaigns, celebrations and other parish events.]


[Movement Building and Advocacy #3: Celebrate Laudato Si Week & the Season of Creation (1 Sept to 4 Oct) every year]

[Ecological Accountability #14: Stop the use of polystyrene/Styrofoam, single use plastics and other ecologically harmful or wasteful disposables for all church operations and activities. Opt for reusable items instead.]

Ecological Accountability #3: Commit to upholding and promoting the 7Rs : Refuse, Reduce, Reuse, Repurpose, Recycle, Redesign, and Regenerate. Set measurable targets as appropriate.

We lose 10 football fields of tropical rainforest every minute. Deforestation is wiping out precious plant and animal species and contributing to global warming. When we kill our forests, we kill life and endanger the future of forest communities, our children and other living entities on Earth.

All parishes, church organisations/offices/houses of formation, and all the faithful are earnestly called to implement & promote these practices now:

#### 1. USE LESS PAPER & WOOD

- · Minimise photocopying and paper use
- Stop using paper plates, cups, containers, wrapping, etc.
- Stop consuming boxed drinks
- Reduce, reuse, repurpose and recycle cardboard and wood
- Stop buying products made from rainforest wood

#### 2. REGENERATE DIFFERENT VARIETIES OF LOCAL TREES

- Every family to plant & nurture at least one local tree in the year
- Every parish to plant & nurture at least 3 local trees in the year
